Answers and Explanations

Taj Mahal, India – These are proper nouns as they are specific names.

c) indices – The plural of index is either indexes (common) or indices (technical/mathematical).

c) Idea – It is countable; the others are uncountable.

b) The research was groundbreaking. – "Research" is uncountable.

Honesty – It is an abstract noun, representing a quality.

The board – Synonym for "committee" as a collective noun.

b) Mouse – The plural is "mice," an irregular form.

b) flock – A group of geese in flight is called a flock.

children's – Correct possessive form for plural noun not ending in "s."

What he believes – Functions as a noun clause.

c) loyalty – Correct noun form of "loyal."

c) phenomena – Correct plural of "phenomenon."

a) criticism – Uncountable noun form.

perfume – A tangible, concrete noun.

b) dining table – A compound noun.

fish – "Fish" is plural in most contexts.

b) humility – Correct abstract noun.

b) The courage she displayed was inspiring. – "Courage" is abstract.

Error: "an advice" – Advice is uncountable, so "some advice" is correct.

The leaf is falling from the tree. – Singular nouns used.

b) Everest – Specific proper noun for a mountain.

flock – Collective noun for sheep.

b) There is little information about the new policy. – "Information" is uncountable.

James's – Both James' and James's are correct, but usage depends on style.

The Ganga flows through the city. – Replaced "river" with a proper noun.
