Answers and Explanations

1. *b) had* – The past perfect tense is used in third conditional sentences to show actions that didn't happen.
2. *b) had reached* – The past perfect tense is used to show that one action was completed before another past action.
3. *a) go* – The present simple tense is used for habitual actions.
4. *b) Neither of the two students has finished their assignment.* – "Neither" is singular, so the verb should be "has."
5. *b) to* – The verb "look forward to" is followed by a gerund (meeting).
6. *a) an* – "An" is used before words starting with a vowel sound.
7. *c) was reading* – The past continuous tense is used to indicate an ongoing action in the past.
8. *c) She will finish her homework when she gets home.* – The future tense is used to talk about future actions, and "when" is used for future time clauses.
9. *c) were* – The subjunctive form "were" is used in hypothetical situations in conditional sentences.
10. *b) will have completed* – The future perfect tense is used to show that an action will be completed before a specific point in the future.
11. *b) from* – "From ... to" is used to describe a time period.
12. *c) She likes to cook, read, and travel.* – When listing activities, the infinitive form (to + verb) is correct.
13. *a) for* – "For" is used with durations of time (five years).
14. *b) when* – "When" is used for time-related conditions in future situations.
15. *b) An* – "An" is used before words starting with a vowel sound.
16. *a) goes* – The present simple tense is used for habitual actions.
17. *d) had arrived* – The past perfect tense is used to show that one action occurred before another in the past.
18. *a) since* – "Since" is used to refer to a starting point in time.
19. *a) if* – "If" is used for hypothetical situations or conditions.
20. *a) first* – "First" is used as an ordinal number to indicate the position.
21. *b) The team is playing very well this season.* – "Team" is a collective noun, treated as singular.
22. *c) were* – The subjunctive form "were" is used in hypothetical situations.

23. *b) on* – "On" is used with days or dates to indicate time.

24. *b) He has been working at the company for five years.* – "At" is used to refer to a specific place or organization.

25. *b) have* – The present perfect tense is used with plural subjects (they).
