Answers and Explanations

1. **a) goes** – Present Simple for habitual actions or general truths.
2. **c) haven't seen** – Present Perfect to express actions that have not been completed up to the present.
3. **a) We have been waiting for the bus for an hour.** – Present Perfect Continuous to show the action started in the past and is still continuing.
4. **c) has been studying** – Present Perfect Continuous to show an action started in the past and continues up to now.
5. **c) I have worked in the company since 2010.** – Present Perfect to indicate an action that started in the past and continues.
6. **c) has already finished** – Present Perfect to describe a completed action with relevance to the present.
7. **b) have lived** – Present Perfect to describe an action that started in the past and continues.
8. **a) He has been learning Spanish for two years.** – Present Perfect Continuous to show ongoing action that started in the past.
9. **c) haven't completed** – Present Perfect to express actions not completed at the present moment.
10. **c) are studying** – Present Continuous to describe an action happening now.
11. **c) I have been reading this book for two days.** – Present Perfect Continuous to describe an action that has been ongoing for a period of time.
12. **c) has been writing** – Present Perfect Continuous to describe an ongoing action that started in the past.
13. **c) have never visited** – Present Perfect to describe an experience up to the present.
14. **d) have been waiting** – Present Perfect Continuous to indicate an ongoing action that began in the past.
15. **b) is studying, will take** – Present Continuous for the current action, Future Simple for the future action.
16. **c) They have been repairing the car for three hours.** – Present Perfect Continuous to show an ongoing action over a period of time.
17. **b) haven't finished** – Present Perfect to express an unfinished action up to the present.
18. **b) is studying** – Present Continuous to show an action happening now.
19. **a) travel** – Present Simple for habitual actions.

20. **b) I have been working here since two years.** – Present Perfect Continuous for an ongoing action that started in the past.
21. **a) has not seen** – Present Perfect to describe an action that has not happened yet.
22. **c) had been waiting** – Past Perfect Continuous to describe an action that was happening before another action in the past.
23. **a) We have been working on the project for two weeks.** – Present Perfect Continuous to describe an ongoing action that started in the past.
24. **d) haven't met** – Present Perfect to express something that hasn't happened up to the present.
25. **a) I have been trying to reach you for the last hour.** – Present Perfect Continuous to show ongoing action.
