- 4. c) will have lived Future Perfect indicates the completion of an action by a certain point in the future.
- 5. a) will call Future Simple for a scheduled future action.
- 6. **d) will have been working** Future Perfect Continuous for a duration of action leading up to a point in the future.
- 7. **d) will have been living** Future Perfect Continuous indicates an ongoing action that will have been happening for a certain duration by a future time.
