1. **b) will have finished** – Future Perfect is used for an action that will be completed before a specific time in the future.
2. **c) will be lying** – Future Continuous indicates an ongoing action in the future.
3. **a) I will have finished my work before she arrives.** – Future Perfect for an action completed before another future event.
4. **c) will have lived** – Future Perfect indicates the completion of an action by a certain point in the future.
5. **a) will call** – Future Simple for a scheduled future action.
6. **d) will have been working** – Future Perfect Continuous for a duration of action leading up to a point in the future.
7. **d) will have been living** – Future Perfect Continuous indicates an ongoing action that will have been happening for a certain duration by a future time.
8. **a) By the time they arrive, I will have cleaned the house.** – Future Perfect for an action that will be completed before another future event.
9. **c) will be traveling** – Future Continuous for a planned or expected action at a specific future time.
10. **b) will not have finished** – Future Perfect negative form, for an action that will not be completed before another future event.
11. **b) will have completed** – Future Perfect for an action completed by a specific point in the future.
12. **b) will be having** – Future Continuous for a planned event in the future at a specific time.
13. **a) By next year, I will have been studying here for five years.** – Future Perfect Continuous for ongoing action up to a certain time in the future.
14. **c) will be watching** – Future Continuous for an action in progress at a specific time in the future.
15. **a) I will have been working here for 10 years by 2023.** – Future Perfect Continuous for an action that will have been in progress for a specified duration by a future point.
16. **b) will have left** – Future Perfect for an action completed before another future event.
17. **c) will have finished** – Future Perfect for an action that will be completed by a future point in time.
18. **a) will arrive** – Future Simple for a planned event or action.
19. **c) will have been** – Future Perfect for a completed action that started in the past and will continue up until a certain future point.
