2. b) *most intelligent* – The superlative form of "intelligent" requires "most" (because it is a multi-syllable adjective).
3. b) *more complicated* – The comparative form of "complicated" requires "more".
4. b) *She is much taller than I am.* – "Taller" is the correct comparative form of "tall".
5. a) *colder* – The comparative form of "cold" is "colder".
6. c) *friendlier* – The comparative form of "friendly" is "friendlier".
7. a) *more beautiful* – The comparative form of "beautiful" requires "more".
8. b) *most exciting* – The superlative form of "exciting" is "most exciting".
9. a) *better* – "Better" is the comparative form of "good".
10. b) *cheaper* – The comparative form of "cheap" is "cheaper".
11. a) *more* – "More" is used for the comparative form of "many".
12. b) *more expensive* – The comparative form of "expensive" requires "more".
13. a) *youngest* – The superlative form of "young" is "youngest".
14. c) *most talented* – The superlative form of "talented" requires "most".
15. a) *more interesting* – "More interesting" is the correct comparative form of "interesting".
16. a) *most beautiful* – The superlative form of "beautiful" requires "most".
