### Answers and Explanations

1. a) *beautifully* – The adverb form of "beautiful" is "beautifully".
2. c) *harder* – The comparative form of "hard" is "harder".
3. b) *quickly* – The adverb form of "quick" is "quickly".
4. b) *faster* – The comparative form of "fast" is "faster".
5. a) *more fluently* – "Fluently" is a two-syllable adverb, so the comparative form uses "more".
6. a) *less* – "Less" is used for the comparative form of "little".
7. b) *later* – The comparative form of "late" is "later".
8. b) *earlier* – The comparative form of "early" is "earlier".
9. d) *easier* – The comparative form of "easy" is "easier".
10. b) *fastest* – The superlative form of "fast" is "fastest".
11. a) *worse* – The comparative form of "bad" is "worse".
12. a) *funniest* – The superlative form of "funny" is "funniest".
13. a) *louder* – The comparative form of "loud" is "louder".
14. c) *slower* – The comparative form of "slow" is "slower".
