- 6. c) the "The" is used to refer to a specific item (book given by someone).
- 7. c) the "The" is used to refer to a specific noun (the only person I trust).
- 8. b) any "Any" is used in negative statements or questions when referring to an unspecified amount.
- 9. d) some "Some" refers to an unspecified amount in a positive statement.
